Introduce CGM and Components



Review **Dexcom G6 Overview** and **What it Does** in the Start Here guide.

Set Up Display Device



Dexcom G6 App*: Download and open

- 1. Agree to data consent
- 2. Create new log-in (if not created previously)
- 3. Read and step through set-up screens
- 4. Follow onscreen instructions to:
 - Customise Low, High and Urgent Low Soon Alerts
 - Enter Sensor Code to avoid daily calibrations
 - Enter Transmitter serial number

Receiver: To turn on the Receiver, press and hold the button for 2 seconds.

Insert Sensor and Attach Transmitter



- Watch instructional video on how to insert sensor and attach transmitter on the AMSL Diabetes YouTube page
- Choose sensor site (abdomen for 18 years and older, abdomen or upper buttocks for 2-17 years)
- Insert sensor with applicator
- Snap in transmitter

Pair Transmitter and Start Sensor



- 1. Wait for transmitter to pair
- 2. Tap Start Sensor
 - No readings during 2-hour warmup
 - Keep display device within 6 metres during warmup

Home Screen Overview



Review **Home Screen Overview** in **Using Your G6 guide** with. Home screen shows:

- Sensor Glucose Reading
- Trend Arrow
- Trend Graph
- High and Low Alert Levels

Review Home screen settings:

- Review alert options: Urgent Low, Urgent Low Soon, Low, High, Rise Rate, Fall Rate, Signal Loss and No Readings. Review Repeat and Sounds options for each alert
- Repeat above for second alert schedule if desired: choose Day/Time preferences, Repeat and Sound options

Treatment Decisions



Review Treatment Decisions in Using Your G6 guide.

Use your meter if:

- Your Dexcom G6 readings don't match your symptoms
- Your Dexcom G6 doesn't show both a number and arrow

Ending Sensor Session

Review Ending Your Sensor Session in Using Your G6 guide.

- Remove sensor and transmitter together from body
- Remove transmitter from holder and clean using an alcohol swab
- Keep transmitter
